As you are aware, the City of Southgate opened bids on Wednesday, August 8, 2018 for the above referenced project and received bids from two (2) of the three (3) contractors that picked up contract documents. Attached is a copy of the bid tabulation.

Our office has reviewed the two (2) bids received and in summary, bids received were as follows:

Fer-Pal Construction USA

\$1,158,611.25

Lanzo Construction

\$2,975,000.00

This project involves the installation of cured-in-place liners along two (2) water mains within the City that are prone to water main breaks and located under the influence of pavements. Work proposed is very similar to the water main lining work that was completed last Fall along Northline Road, Dix-Toledo Highway, Eureka Road and Helen Avenue. The locations to be completed this year are as follows:

- East Side of Dix-Toledo Highway from south of Northline Road to Brest Road (12")
- North Side of Northline Road from Dix-Toledo Highway to Burns Avenue (8")

Fer-Pal Construction USA has completed all three (3) previous water main lining projects for the City of Southgate and has completed water main lining projects for the City of Garden City and Huron Charter Township administered through our office within the past five (5) years and have found their work to be of good quality and are very organized, very knowledgeable of water supply systems and very qualified to complete this year's water main lining work proposed for the City of Southgate.

Therefore, based upon the bids received and past experience, it is our recommendation for the City Council to consider at their August 15, 2018 meeting to t award the 2018 Water Main Lining Program to Fer-Pal Construction, Inc. of Taylor, Michigan in the amount of \$1,158,611.25, plus a ten (10) percent contingency for a total amount of \$1,274,472.38

I have requested and reviewed three quotes from fire apparatus vendors. With a bid waiver the city will save on administrative hours. The industry and municipalities have scaled-down on purchasing fire apparatus that have multiple unnecessary options that in time will need repair. The three quotes are from stock units, this only means the trucks are mass produced to be sold with minimal add on option. All fire pumpers are NFPA 1901 Compliant specifications.

I am requesting the purchase of an E-ONE pumper from Westshore Fire, 6620 Lake Michigan DR. Allendale MI, 49401. In the amount of \$444,000 however there would be savings of \$13,000 dollars if the city were to prepay for the truck the cost would drop to \$431,000. This was not the lowest quote of the three (see attachment)





The Police Department has been doing upgrades to the men's and women's locker rooms. With the sponsorship of Lowes we received their support and assistance with the use of The Home Town Hero's funds. Lowes was able to provide volunteers to help with the renovation of both locker rooms. Lowes donated some new bathroom fixtures as well as all new tile, carpet and paint. The final step is to add the lockers back into the newly renovated rooms.

We reached out to several different manufacturers whose cost ranged as high as \$63,300.

Salsbury Industries came in with the lowest quote for forty eight open access designer wood lockers. The cost is \$550.00 per unit for a total of \$26,400. They are offering us a 25% discount for our purchase for a total cost of \$19,800 which will also include free freight charges.

It is my recommendation that the purchase of forty eight open access designer wood lockers be awarded to Salsbury Industries, 1010 East 62nd Street Los Angeles, Ca 90001 in the amount of \$19,800.00. With your concurrence, I respectfully request this item be placed on the City Council's agenda for the meeting scheduled on September 5, 2018 for purpose of a waiver of bid request and purchase approval. Adequate funding is available in the State Forfeiture Account, this purchase falls under the guidelines that governs the use of these funds.


