

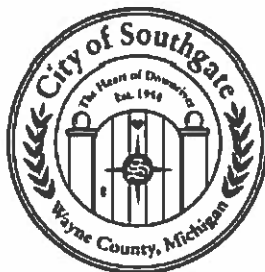

Re: Setting Public Hearing Dates for Southgate's Community Development Block Grant Program; 2016-2017 Program Application

It is time to begin the application process for the Community Development Block Grant program (CDBG) for Funding Year 2016-2017. The City is proposing the following projects for the upcoming program year:

- Senior Services - \$20,909
- Housing Rehabilitation - \$49,749
- Municipal ADA Improvement Projects - \$45,000
- Pedestrian Way Improvements - \$30,000
- Administration (and Planning) - \$10,000

This proposal is consistent with the City's program goals, allowing Southgate to maintain the current level of support to our senior services. Also, we will once again offer direct grants to our residents by supporting the housing rehabilitation program. Finally, the City is hoping to continue our successful municipal wide ADA accessibility program, which has included our entrance ways, neighborhood improvements and as well as other public facilities.

The Administration is requesting the City Council adopt a resolution setting a public hearing date for Wednesday, January 20th at 7:00 p.m.

Thank you for your time and consideration to the CDBG program. Our team will be present at the public hearing on January 20th to discuss the 2016-2017 program.
