1060.08(f) Approved Incinerator Use (THIS SECTION DELETED IN ITS ENTIRETY)

*new (f) Open Burning. Open burning of garbage, rubbish and refuse is hereby prohibited. However, a permit for the disposal of waste from building operations and land clearing, and for the disposal of other large accumulations of waste, may be obtained from the Fire chief or his or her duly designated representative, which permit shall state the terms and conditions under which the authority granted under such permit may be exercised. Such terms and conditions shall be at the discretion of the Fire chief or his or her duly designated representative.

*new (g) Open-Type Storage Receptacles. The use of roll-off, open-type containers of twenty yards or more for trash and refuse storage is hereby prohibited, except at construction sites.

Section 2. Saving Clause. Nothing in this Ordinance or in the Code hereby adopted shall be construed to affect any suit or proceeding pending in any court, or any rights acquired, or liability incurred, or any cause or causes of action acquired or existing, under any act or ordinance hereby repealed; nor shall any just or legal right or remedy of any character be lost, impaired or affected by this Ordinance.

Section 3. Severability. Should any word, sentence, phrase or any portion of this Ordinance be held in a manner invalid by any court or competent jurisdiction or by any state agency having authority to do so for any reason whatsoever, such holdings shall be construed and limited to such word, sentence, phrase or any portion of the Ordinance held to be so invalid shall not be construed as affecting the validity of any of the remaining words, sentences, phrases or portions of this Ordinance.


