468.02 PARKING DURING SNOW EMERGENCIES

- (a) A snow emergency shall be in effect in the City whenever a notice of a storm warning is declared by one or both of the following:
 - (1) The Mayor, upon the advice and consent of the Director of Public Services, Chief of Police (or a designee), or the Superintendent of the Department of Public Service (or a designee); and/or
- <u>Section 2.</u> Saving Clause. Nothing in this Ordinance or in the Code hereby adopted shall be construed to affect any suit or proceeding pending in any court, or any rights acquired, or liability incurred, or any cause or causes of action acquired or existing, under any act or ordinance hereby repealed; nor shall any just or legal right or remedy of any character be lost, impaired or affected by this Ordinance.
- <u>Section 3.</u> Severability. Should any word, sentence, phrase or any portion of this Ordinance be held in a manner invalid by any court or competent jurisdiction or by any state agency having authority to do so for any reason whatsoever, such holdings shall be construed and limited to such work, sentence, phrase or any portion of the Ordinance held to be so invalid shall not be construed as affecting the validity of any of the remaining words, sentences, phrases or portions of this Ordinance.
- <u>Section 4.</u> Conflicting Ordinances. All prior existing ordinances adopted by the City of Southgate inconsistent or in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are, to the extent of such conflict or inconsistency, hereby expressly repealed.
